



IAPH Conference Bursary

The IAPH provides funding for conferences or history-related events. One award will be made annually. Reflecting the ethos of the Association, the award will be given to an event which reaches beyond the academy and has an innovative strategy for public engagement. The event should also include early career researchers and ensure gender balance on discussion or conference panels. The value of the award is up to €400, and the event will be promoted on the IAPH website and through its social media.

The deadline for applications is 15 January 2019. The award will be announced at the AGM in the spring of 2019. Applications will be accepted for events taking place between April 2019 and April 2020.

Eligibility

- Applicants must be members of the Irish Association of Professional Historians.
- Grants cannot be sought retrospectively.

Criteria for Assessment

In making its funding decisions, the Grants Committee of the IAPH uses the following criteria:

- The applicant has provided a detailed budget which is attached to the application.
- The applicant has a clear strategy for public engagement.
- The event includes the participation of early career researchers.
- The applicant has ensured gender balance on discussion/conference panels.

Application Process

- You should complete an application form in full. The application form can be found below.
- The deadline for applications is 15 January 2019. Late applications will not be considered.
- All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by the end of March 2019.

Payment of grants

- One Conference Grant will be awarded each year. Please note that 50 per cent of the award will be issued to the successful applicant in advance of the proposed event and 50

per cent will be issued up to three months afterwards upon submission of receipts (to cover the entire amount of the award). If the receipts total less than €400 the lesser amount will be issued to the applicant.

- The support of the IAPH should be acknowledged on all publicity material relating to the event.
- Successful applicants will be required to provide a description of the uses to which the grant has been made within one month of the completion of the training event. This report (of 500 words) will be published on the IAPH website. Full payment of the grant will not be issued until the report has been submitted.
